**READ THIS FORM CAREFULLY!!!!** Decide which method of collection you wish to pursue. Then, contact the court clerk's office for the proper forms for that method. **It is up to you to initiate collection procedures.** The clerk is **not** an attorney and must abstain from giving legal advise.

The person in whose favor judgment was entered may pursue collection in one of the following manners. Judgment cannot be enforced until at least ten (10) days after the date the judgment is entered, nor can it be enforced if there is an appeal with a supersedeas bond filed.

Each of the following options for collection of judgment involve additional fees which must be paid, initially, by the person seeking garnishment or execution, but these will be added to the judgment against the other party.

**OPTIONS FOR COLLECTION OF JUDGMENT**

- 1. Obtain a Writ of Garnishment of wages**
- 2. Obtain a Writ of Garnishment of bank account**
- 3. Obtain a Writ of Execution of personal property**

**SATISFACTION OF JUDGMENT**

When the judgment is paid, the person in whose FAVOR judgment was entered **MUST** file the following satisfaction of judgment with the Court within sixty (60) days of receiving full satisfaction.
